If you haven't started using Free Traffic System yet, then you should be. If you want your search engine rankings to climb, then this system is a must for you to use.

In a nutshell, Free Traffic System is a public blog network. What this means is that you take the articles which you are already producing (you are producing articles, right?) and distribute them to multiple blogs within your niche in the network.

You might now ask, "well I'm already distributing my articles to article directories, so isn't this good enough?". And the answer is noooooooooooooo!. Now it's good that you are submitting to multiple article directories and you should continue doing this, but realize that this produces a lot of low quality links (which is okay as we need lots of these low quality links so that our linking appears natural to the search engines)

So what's the difference with using public blog networks? Well you are going to take those same articles that you are already using and place backlinks within the body of the text. Note that this is quite different than using a resource box with article directory submissions. You will now place each article on multiple blogs within the network.

Realize that Google loves blogs and Google particularly loves backlinks that are that are build into the text of blog posts. Why is this? I don't know, you'll have to go and ask Google.

All I do know is that the process has incredible results. This is particularly true if you have been getting hung up for a while with your search engine positioning for your various keywords. Using blog networks will give you the boost that you need.
